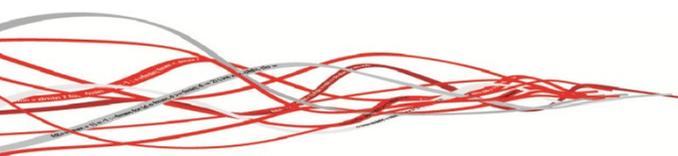

Environment Reporter (ER) is a utility that analyses your system build environment and creates a report for internal and external use. The ER does not transmit any information without your explicit permission and you may edit the report prior to submission to Programming Research.

2. Installation Note

Environment Reporter is a utility that do not require to be installed.

User can run ER in Graphical User Interface (GUI) mode by simply double click or Command line Interface mode (CLI) by specifying `--cli` option.

USAGE: EnvironmentReporter [OPTIONS]
PRQA Environment Reporter Application

<code>-h, --help</code>	Display help information on command line arguments
<code>-l<level>, --log-level=<level></code>	Define log level (error/debug/warning/information)
<code>--gui</code>	Set GUI mode if possible, otherwise fall-back to command line version (default)
<code>--cli</code>	Force command line interface
